Qualifications

- Ideally at least one year of post-secondary education
- Standard First Aid and Class 'C' CPR
- Clear Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Persons Search
- Clear Child Welfare Check
- Ability to take initiative and a strong work ethic
- Proven communication and teamwork skills
- Experience working at an outdoor education centre or summer camp
- Wilderness Advanced First Aid or Wilderness First Responder is an Asset
- ACCT accredited ropes facilitator training (e.g. Adventureworks Levels I or II)

General Responsibilities

- Provide Camp Leadership during a groups experience at our facility
- Facilitate outdoor programs (hikes, orienteering, archery, team building, etc.)
- Facilitate challenge course programs (high ropes, climbing wall, giant swing)

Specific Duties

- Apply risk management techniques and appropriate safety protocols
- Ensure all buildings and program areas are ready and clean before and after a groups' visits
- Maintain equipment through appropriate repairs
- Ensure equal opportunities are available for participation through utilization of adventure-based learning techniques, such as Challenge by Choice
- Promote a positive attitude towards stewardship of our natural environment.
- Perform other duties as required.
